**Race Timings**

1	.... : ....	<b>Pursuit Race from Pontoon Line to a finish off Hurst Spit.</b>
2	.... : ....	<b>Rowing Race for the Collins Cup. (craft to be minimum 4ft. beam – excluding any outriggers.)</b>
3	.... : ....	<b>Sailing Race from Hurst Beach back to the Pontoon Line.</b>

- Races 1 & 3 will be open to all sailing dinghies. Handicaps to be used will be taken from the HCSC Handicap List, or the RYA PN list. Any craft without a number on one of those lists will be allocated a handicap by the Race Committee.
- Enter for Races 1 & 3 at the Clubhouse up until ... : ..., or on Hurst Beach up until ... : ....
- Enter for Race 2 on Hurst Beach up until ... : ...
- Races 1 & 3 will be planned to last approximately 45 minutes each.
- Course and start times for Race 1 will be given during the briefing at ... : ...
- Courses for Collins Cup Race and Race 3 will be announced on the Hurst Beach approximately 15 minutes before the start of the respective races.
- The Beach Committee will be identifiable by a mast dressed with bunting and a HCSC burgee.
- All craft to be covered by third party insurance to a minimum of £3M per claim.
- All competitors to sign on for the event using the standard HCSC Entry Form.
